With construction formally commencing on the 530-megawatt (MW) Stockyard Hill Wind Farm following satisfaction of the pre-construction conditions of the planning and environmental approvals recently.

Works have commenced on redeveloping the local public road network that the construction traffic is able to use, this includes the following:

- Dunnets Road construction of a laneway for construction traffic
- The redevelopment of the intersection of Skipton Road and Dunnets Road
- The redevelopment of Thompsons Road

There may be some minor interruption to traffic in the coming weeks due to upgrades of these roads.

Works will continue to be focussed on the central/western area of the wind farm (accessed off Stockyard Hill Rd near Stockyard-Hill Wangatta Road) with the quarry operations, establishment of the construction compounds and initial access road construction.

Works will also commence on the southern section of the wind farm (Mt Emu Settlement Road). Quarry materials will be trucked in from the quarry south of Skipton for the construction of this area of the wind farm.
